### REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors, welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates **Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time.**

Today's reading says that the impetus for the calling of the twelve disciples was when Jesus saw the crowds and felt compassion for them. They were 'harrassed and dejected'. It was the very reason that he had left heaven and come to earth in the first place, but he could not help them on his own. He chose a very mixed bunch to be his helpers. Some of the names are very familiar to us; others less so. Judas Iscariot is known for all the wrong reasons. Many joined them later in the work, including many women. But from this group of ordinary people, the church was born. Each one of us is called, in the Spirit, to continue Christ's work according to our individual gifts. Not one of us is too unskilled, or too clever, or simply too sinful to share in this work. Rejoice that He has chosen us to share his work of compassion and hope and equips us to do it.
