REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors , welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates **Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, *Corpus Christi***.

Having focussed last week on the Holy Trinity, this week we focus on the amazing gift of the Incarnation in the body of Jesus, the human being, and the even more amazing gift of the Eucharist and His continuing presence with us until the end of time.
