REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors , welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates **Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time.**

Not surprisingly, the people who had been fed by Jesus with the loaves and fishes came back for more. But Jesus is very understanding. He accepts this, and points it out to them, but goes on to say that he has something far more important to offer. He answers their questions kindly, and tells them of a new order of life where there is food which lasts into our future

life in heaven. They ask him what they must do. He replies in language that they can understand: they must do what God commands, but also accept that he, Jesus, has been sent by this same God, who is his Father. That is a big 'ask'. It was God who gave them manna in the wilderness, and God who has sent Jesus. What will Jesus give? He replies that he will give himself. This passage has to be read in the context of the Eucharist. How else can they understand what Jesus is saying?
