REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors, welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates **Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time.**



Today's readings are all about the kindness of Jesus. If the psalm was describing one of your friends, he or she would be someone you really liked and wanted to cherish. Yes - Jesus is a Person of the Trinitarian God of infinite power and authority, but also expresses God's unimaginable love and tenderness towards us. He came on earth to show us this love and care, and to be a friend who helps us with our burdens, toils and aspirations.
