

### REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors , welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates **the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord**.



The interesting part of this account is that John the Baptist almost refused to baptise Jesus. Jesus was sinless: how could he possibly need baptising? But Jesus was not only setting an example for his future followers: he was, by this very act, blessing the water. It shows also Jesus' total humility: he was willing to act as a sinner needing repentance and cleansing. He was completely exonerated; he rose up immediately, the dove descended and the voice from Heaven declared his true identity: 'This is my Son, the beloved; my favour rests on him.' Personal reassurance or special private words of encouragement still happen to us all and are immensely valuable. They can come from anywhere: friends, prayer, reading, family, even strangers. Our task is to listen and learn how to recognise these heaven-prompted insights. They lead us and help us to live in harmony with the will of our heavenly Father and to find our true and deep identity, in Him.
