REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors , welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates **Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time.**



One of the recurring themes in the gospels is that God KNOWS us. Today we are reminded that God knows us intimately, even down to the ‘number of hairs on our head’. Many times also we read that Jesus looked at people: He saw their needs and responded, seeing deep into their hearts. This can be deeply consoling or deeply disturbing. If we allow this to happen, without running away to hide, then He is able to heal us gradually, at depth, and we begin to really love Him for who He is. This loving gaze brings us in touch with our real self and brings us to life: urgent, passionate, peaceful, purposeful and joyous life. Then His words make sense: we do not need to be afraid - we are loved and protected by the Father. Our response is to share these truths whenever and wherever we are in ways appropriate to our gifts and individual calling. And we will be welcomed in heaven.
