REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors, welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates **Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**.

Today we hear that rumours of Jesus' mission and the opposition it aroused had reached his family and they were becoming anxious. Mary herself must have been concerned for his welfare, and agreed to go with her relatives to see what was happening. They found him, as reported, in the middle of crowds of people and were unable to get near him. He was speaking about the 'unforgivable sin' – words surely directed against those who said he was possessed by the devil. If anyone mistakes the love, truth, and beauty of the Holy Spirit as the work of the devil, they are very far from redemption. And his words were very plain: his first responsibility now was to the people who were listening to him. His family were welcome to join the new family he was initiating. We read in Acts that later on they were indeed involved. And Mary, his mother, was given tenderly into the care of the Beloved disciple. His care for her lasted to the end.
