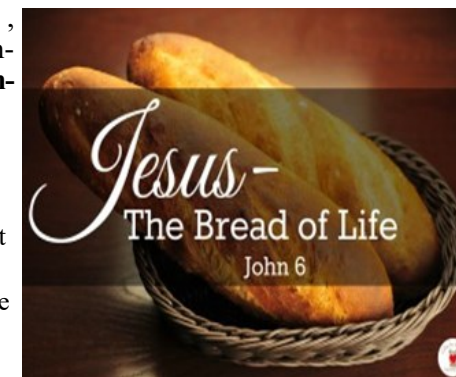

### REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors , welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates **Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**.

Today's gospel is very familiar to most of us. Focusing on Jesus himself, we can see evidence in his face of his great compassion as he looks at the crowd, so hungry to be with him and to hear his teaching. This is his chance to prepare people for his future indescribable gift of the Eucharist. But it also links him with the great prophet Elisha, who also fed a multitude, and with Moses

and the manna in the desert. He wanted people to make the connection: he is the Son of God. And Jesus took the bread that the young boy offered, as he takes each one of us in his hands. He offered it to his Father, giving thanks for it. He offers *us* also to the Father and gives thanks for *us*. He broke the bread in his hands, as we are so often broken, but it was not destroyed. It was given to the disciples to distribute to feed the hungry.
