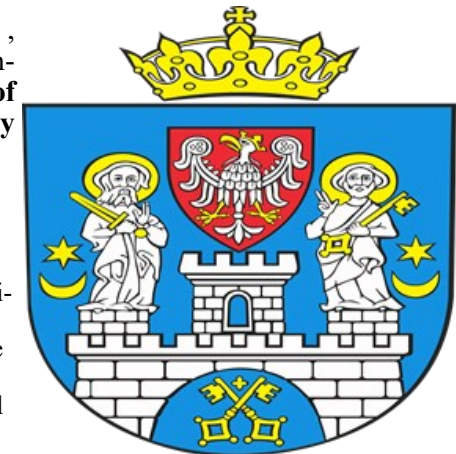

REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors , welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday our diocese celebrates **the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles. Secondary Patrons of the Diocese.**

The putting together of Sts. Peter and Paul - the two apostles who 'share one throne' - is extraordinarily symbolic. It reflects perfectly the dual nature of our Church.
