REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors, welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates **Holy Trinity Sunday**.



Attempts to explain the mystery of the Trinity, Three Persons in one God, are rarely adequate, if ever. It makes no human sense. Yet we experience such realities many times. Two people in marriage with a newly born child can feel a deep unity of love. They are a family. We can all experience a one-ness with others when listening to a sublime piece of music, or watching an exceptionally beautiful sunset or fear mixed with awe, say, at an erupting volcano. In communal prayer or worship we can feel a closeness, a 'one-ness' with the rest of the congregation. But our individuality is never lost. Today's readings encourage us to love one another - to allow the experience of one-ness to take root in our very being, to share in the joy, the suffering, the needs, successes and triumphs of other people. Then we shall truly become ourselves: a loved and individually recognised person in the utterly overwhelming loving Presence of the Three in One.
