REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors, welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates **Thirty First Sunday in Ordinary Time**.

Today Jesus reveals to us the bedrock of our faith: firstly, to love God with all our strength, our heart, our mind and our soul; secondly, to love our neighbour as ourselves. All the rest springs from this. To love God is to love his handiwork, wherever we find it. This includes truth, beauty, small acts of mercy, laughter, innocence and all else. It means looking out for these and noticing when our heart is moved or cries out in wonder. We are uniting with God in His creativity and care. When we respond, we are beginning to pray. How can we love God when we know nothing of Him because we have failed to notice and acknowledge his actions? Love responds to love. So we seek to know more about God, his actions, his reality, through our prayer, our worship, our learning and our relationships. This does not come without heartbreak. But Christ came to heal the broken-hearted.
