REFLECTION

Dear parishioners, Friends and Visitors, welcome to St Mary on the Quay. This Sunday the Church celebrates Sixth Sunday of Easter.

Once again we contemplate the New Jerusalem and the glory of Christ in heaven, but the reading is coupled with Jesus' last words to us who are still living our mortal lives.
